It is with deep sorrow that we have to announce the death of Monica Pascoe on 17th December 2023. Many of you will have seen Monica walking around the town and calling into Prim-Raf.

Monica first appeared on stage at Prim-Raf in 1956 in 'As long as they are happy' with Bryon who she had met at Prim-Raf.

Monica appeared in many plays during her lifetime and loved every minute.

She had her own dance school which was held in the W.I. Hall at the top of Haye Road, but later moved to Prim-Raf Theatre, where ballet barres were installed along the walls of the auditorium. Monica's pupils danced in all our Pantos and variety shows until Monica retired. Her other great love was Scottish Dancing, which she attended in Liskeard every week.

One of Monica's big achievements at Prim-Raf was teaching a group of ladies and one gentleman how to tap dance. Only two had any knowledge of this form of dance, so it was a huge challenge to teach them all so that they could all dance for 'Stepping Out'. Monica's last acting role was in 'Lord Arthur Seville's Crime' in October 2011 and then in April 2012 we celebrated her 80th Birthday with 'This Is Your Life'.

Over the last few years Monica became very frail, but she would always call into the theatre when the door was open and watch rehearsals or just have a chat. She loved visiting the theatre where she could relive her very happy memories of her time there. We shall miss her.

Monica's funeral is January 17th and a memorial service will be held in St Mary's Church at 1pm for all those who wish to attend.
